## Silver Swans

Silver Swans ballet classes are specially designed for older learners to help improve mobility, posture, co-ordination and energy levels. Classes are delivered by licensed dance teachers who have undergone specialist training on how to safely adapt ballet teaching techniques and content for older adults. The training focuses on how to teach a high-quality ballet class for learners aged 55 and over, equipping teachers to recognise and respond to the different needs of participants of a broad age range.

Training to become a Silver Swans licensed teacher will be available to qualified dance teachers with the requisite qualifications and experience – not just RAD teachers – during the July 2019 school holidays – between 6 and 21 July 2019. A full schedule of training dates will be available early 2019.
